Faith Focus



Romans 8: 26-39 - Nothing separates us from God's love



What are you convinced of or sure of? How have you seen the spirit help someone or yourself in weakness? Does this passage bring you comfort or concern and why?



Paul writes that the spirit is present in the world and that there is no way that anything that the world throws at us will separate us from the love of God. This is a promise to cling to not only when crisis happens but in our everyday lives and our everyday sin. It can be difficult to embrace this full concept of grace for ourselves and the world and yet it is for this very promise that Jesus went to the cross and rose from the grave.

Talk about what ways you see God in the world. In what ways are you being called to share this gospel with others? How does this affect how you interact with friends, family, and strangers? Where does this message set you free and where does it make you nervous?

This week watch for the spirit in the world and watch for things that try to separate you from God's spirit. Keep a list of things that look like they might come between you and God on a large piece of paper. Then at the end of the week, write the words from Romans 8:38-39 in bold letters over top all of those things on the list. Pray together for the hurts in the world over that piece of paper and thank God for being the light that no darkness can overcome.
