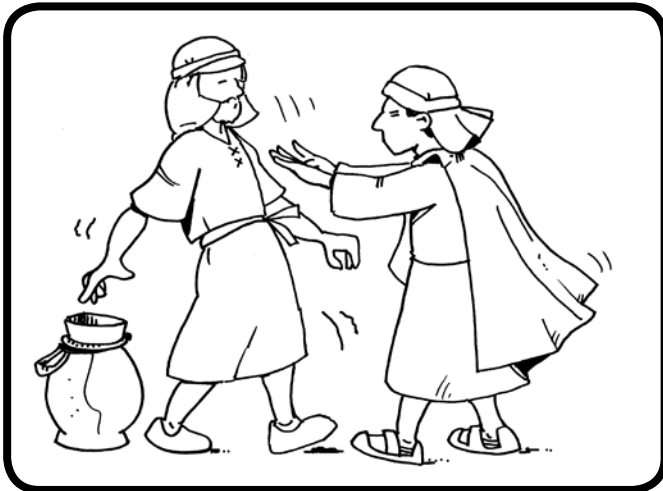


Whoever forgives others is really happy

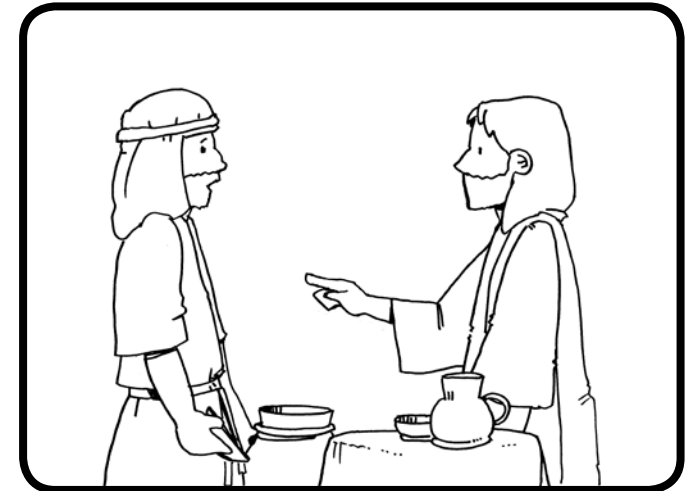
"Go and learn the meaning of the words, 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.'" (Mt 9:13)



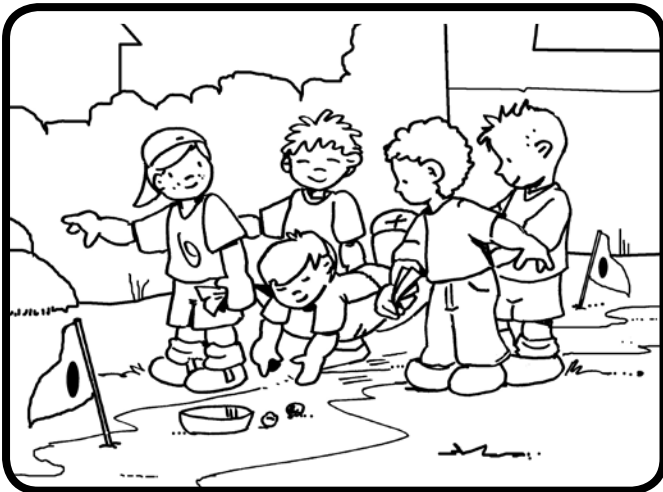

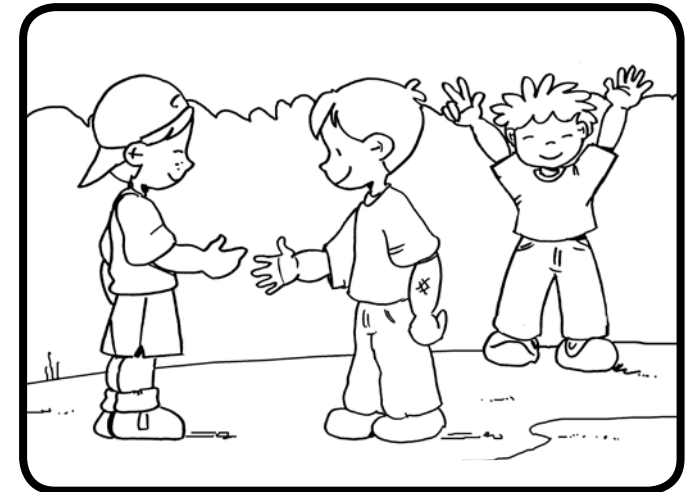
"I tell you, not seven times, but seventy times seven!" Jesus answered. Peter was amazed because that meant you have to forgive all the time! (Mt 18:21-22)
